#### **ODYSSEY I AND II**

#### How To Find the Classrooms

De Smet Jesuit holds all classes in one, three-floor building. Generally, the departments and classes are broken into the following floors:

- First Floor Foreign language, chorus, band, and theology
- Second Floor Social Studies, English, publications
- Third Floor Science, math, and art
- Locker Room Physical education

On your schedule, you will see a room number next to your class. For example, it may say "Biology – Room 306." The first digit represents the floor, and the second and third digits represent the room. So, your biology class is on the third floor in room 306.

#### COMMON PHRASES YOU MIGHT HEAR AT SCHOOL

## A.M.D.G. (Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam)

The Latin phrase for "the greater glory of God;" Jesuit motto.

## **Society of Jesus**

A religious order of priests and brothers founded by St. Ignatius of Loyola in 1540 in Rome. There are more than 17,000 members of the Society of Jesus around the world today.

## Jesuit

A member of the Society of Jesus.

## St. Ignatius of Loyola

Born in 1491 in the Basque region of Spain, Ignatius was a courtier until his conversion at the Battle of Pamplona. He is the founder of the Society of Jesus and author of the Spiritual Exercises and the Constitutions, the two central documents of the Jesuits.

## **Magis**

Latin phrase for "more" or "not settling for the mediocre."

#### **Cura Personalis**

Latin word for "care for the individual person;" a hallmark of Jesuit education.

#### **Graduate at Graduation**

The six pillars of the formation experience of a young man at De Smet. They are: Open to Growth, Religious, Committed to Justice, Loving, Intellectually Competent, and Developing as a Leader.

#### Fr. Pierre De Smet

A 19th century Belgian missionary to North America. His missionary activity began at the confluence of the Mississippi and Missouri Rivers. He is our school's namesake.

## **Spiritual Exercises**

An organized series of spiritual exercises written by Ignatius of Loyola and based on his own experiences. They invite the retreatant to medi-

tate and contemplate on the central mysteries of Christianity (creation, suffering, sin, death and resurrection).

## Finding God in All Things

Ignatian spirituality is summed up in this phrase. It invites a person to search for and find God in every circumstance of life, not just in explicitly religious situations or activities such as prayer in church (Mass) or in private. It implies that God is present everywhere and, though invisible, can be "found" in any and all of the creatures which God has made.

#### The Examen

A prayer used to recall God's presence in one's life that day. It focuses on gratitude and becoming more aware of God's real activity in your daily life.
